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## Terminology:

- Trainee Judge: a person approved by NZCCA to train as a judge - may not judge at a Points Approved Challenge.
- Probationary Judge: a person who has completed judge training and is judging for their first three Points Approved Challenges - may only judge if the other judge is fully qualified.
- Qualified Judge: a person who has completed judge training and probationary judging, and confirmed fully qualified by NZCCA.
